

FULL-TIME GENERAL RADIOLOGIST: VANCOUVER, BC Canada

We are seeking a general academic radiologist with expertise in Emergency/Trauma (ERT) radiology.

Mandatory candidate qualifications include:

- (1) Post-graduate Fellowship training in ERT radiology
- (2) Willing to work *on-site* as the primary radiologist responsible for imaging studies in a Level 1 Trauma Emergency department for routine evening shifts
- (3) Demonstrated capacity to work efficiently in a high volume practice
- (4) Possess a strong interest in clinical teaching at the medical student, resident, and Fellowship level.
- (5) Willing and capable of cross-covering other service areas in the department such as General Ultrasound, General Body CT/MRI and General Radiography.
- (6) Have evidence of research interest.

The *ideal* candidate will also:

- (1) Have subspecialty training in musculoskeletal (MSK) radiology
- (2) Have experience in, and willingness to perform, MSK interventional procedures and expertise in diagnostic and therapeutic ultrasound of the MSK system.

The successful candidate will enjoy a challenging practice including CT, US, MRI and General Radiography in a PACS environment. The remuneration and vacation arrangements are competitive for this geographic region. Following a successful probation period, the candidate will have the opportunity to join this collaborative practice. University appointment at the University of British Columbia will be granted in the clinical stream commensurate with previous rank/experience. Applicants must be currently certified by, or eligible for certification by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada.
